Must-Have Tools and Gear

- ☐ Surge protector
- ☐ Drinking water hose (with filter)
- ☐ Sewer hose and gloves
- ☐ Hose supports
- ☐ Wheel chocks and leveling blocks
- ☐ Tool kit (screwdriver set, pliers, duct tape, headlamp)
- ☐ Water pressure regulator

Tip: Store all setup gear in one easy-to-access bin.

Comfort and Living Essentials

- ☐ RV-safe toilet paper
- ☐ Bed linens and pillows
- ☐ First aid kit (include allergy meds and bug spray)
- ☐ Trash bags
- ☐ Cleaning wipes
- ☐ Collapsible dish rack
- ☐ Compact vacuum or broom
- ☐ Outdoor entry rug (optional but helpful)



Kitchen and Cooking Basics

- ☐ Cast iron skillet or nonstick pan
- ☐ Stackable mixing bowls with lids
- ☐ Measuring cups, utensils, spatula
- ☐ Cutting board and sharp knife
- ☐ Coffee maker or pour-over kit
- ☐ Reusable food containers
- ☐ Outdoor grill or griddle (optional)

Entertainment and Extras

- ☐ Books, board games, or card decks
- ☐ Streaming setup or hotspot device
- ☐ Bluetooth speaker
- ☐ Notebook or travel journal
- ☐ Binoculars
- ☐ One “just for fun” item per person

What to Leave Behind

- Full dish sets (you only need 2–4 of each)
- Extra appliances (choose 1–2 multipurpose ones)
- Large tool collections
- Too many clothes

Outdoor Living Add-Ons

- ☐ Folding camp chairs (plus one extra)
- ☐ Awning mat or outdoor rug
- ☐ String lights or lanterns
- ☐ Bug repellent
- ☐ Citronella candle
- ☐ Portable table
